Please ensure that your child/ren connect with their teacher during the times above and get on with work that has been set.

Teachers will be available between about 9.30 am and 3.30 pm to engage with classes as per their timetable (at the above times) and respond to emails etc. Please respect these times as teachers also need to prepare work, link with their colleagues and look after themselves and their whānau.

We ask that you take care of yourself, your whanau, your community and that we all exhibit kindness at this tough time.
