

Kia ora e te whānau,

Overnight, we have become aware of 2 learners and a staff member testing positive for COVID-19. All affected are isolating and being monitored by their whānau.

With the change in the governments response to Omicron moving to Phase 3 occurring simultaneously to us being notified of the cases, only the household contacts (those living in the same house as the COVID-19 positive person) are deemed to be close contacts.

As a school, we are remaining in Phase 2 of our response plan, as communicated earlier this week.
