

Kia ora Whanau

The Prime Minister has announced that Auckland will move down to Level 2 at 6 am on Sunday 7 March, which means we will be back on-site for school on Monday morning. This is good news!

Please can I remind you of the following Level 2 Regulations that everyone must follow:

- Stay home if you are sick or feel unwell. Parents will need to be prepared to collect learners who become unwell at school. Please update contact details with the office where necessary.
- Hands should be cleaned with soap and water or hand sanitised on entry to classrooms or shared spaces. (Individuals need to have a personal supply of hand sanitiser).
- Use appropriate sneeze and cough etiquette.
- Maintain physical distancing protocol by staying further than the moist breath distance away from others.
- People should bring their own full water bottle each day.
- Use the Covid app where possible, ie, QR code each morning and have Bluetooth turned on.

Further measures we are taking to help ensure safety:

- High traffic areas around the school will be cleaned more frequently, and desks will be wiped down regularly.
- There will be no Morning Korero nor assemblies until we are in Level 1.
- There will be no shared eating environments.
- Meetings will only take place where/when peoples' wellbeing can be managed.
- Any visitors, including parents and whanau, must sign in at the front office if they wish to enter the school grounds.

Buses

- Normal school bus services will resume on Monday 8 March.
- Wearing of masks is not required on school buses, but I do recommend their use.
- If, however, learners travel by public transport, they must wear masks.

We look forward to seeing everyone back at school on Monday.
