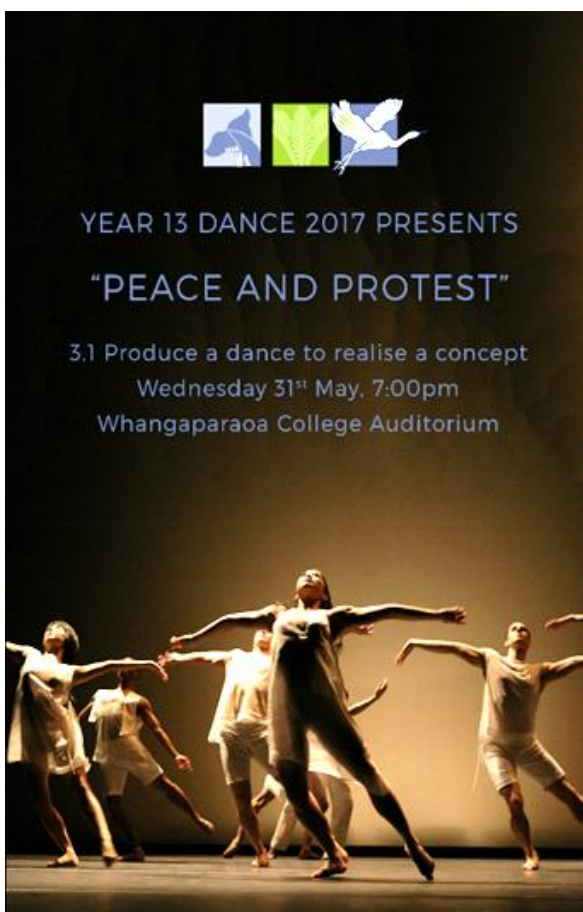

Your child must apply for admission before they can apply for Degree Programmes, Scholarships or Accommodation.

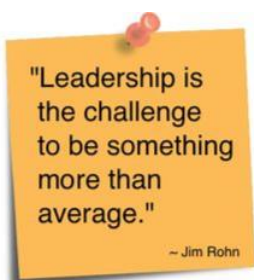
