<b>Brief Description:</b>			
<p>This course looks at continued language progression from level 1 and new sentence structures with a strong focus on korero (speaking), tuhituhi (writing) and Panui reading.</p> <p>Learners will explore different topics ranging from:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Kei te marae (Powhiri)- At the marae</li><li>• Waihanga Tuhinga- Creative writing</li><li>• Tōku Taone- My town</li><li>• Manaaki Marae- Marae hospitality</li><li>• Tikanga Maori- Customs and practices</li></ul> <p>This course further develops language fluency and cultural understanding. Learners taking Maori at yr12 should have some background learning the language. Learners are also expected to be involved with school wide powhiri and community marae events.</p>
