<b>Brief Description:</b>			
<p>This course looks at continued language progression from levels 1 and 2, elaborating on sentence structures with a strong focus on korero (speaking), tuhituhi (writing) and Panui reading.</p> <p>Learners will explore different topics ranging from:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Te Hitori o Aotearoa- NZ history</li><li>• Waihanga tuhinga auaha- Creative writing</li><li>• Kōrero Paki- Story telling</li></ul> <p>This course further develops language fluency and cultural understanding. Learners taking Maori at yr13 are also expected to be involved with school wide powhiri and community marae events.</p>
