Funding Policy

Updated: April 2018

1) Funding

- a. Whangaparaoa College will pursue various funding pathways to allow approved extra and co-curricular activities to be more accessible for learners; and/or to allow development of approved facilities or programmes.
- b. Funding types include donations, fundraising, grant applications and sponsorships.
- c. Donations are gifts, and may be made without ties, to the College in general, whereas other funding is usually, but not always, made with a specific purpose in mind.
- d. Funding not designated for a specific purpose will be considered strategically to ensure the ability for the College to progress objectives taking a school-wide view.

2) Governance

- a. All monies associated with funding activities must be accounted for in accordance with accepted accounting guidelines, and College policies and procedures.
- b. The Principal or his nominee must be consulted
 - Prior to the development of any grant application;
 - Prior to any requests being made for a donation;
 - Prior to the development of any sponsorship relationships;
 - Prior to any planned fundraising activities;to check that the proposed funding, funding arrangement and process is in keeping with the Vision, Mission and Values of the College.
