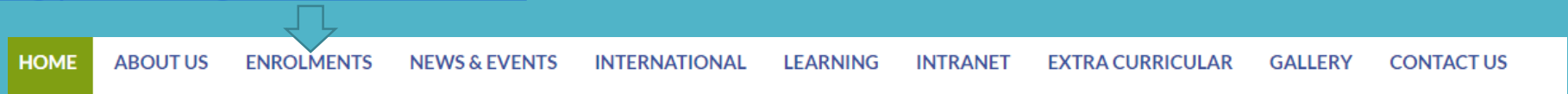
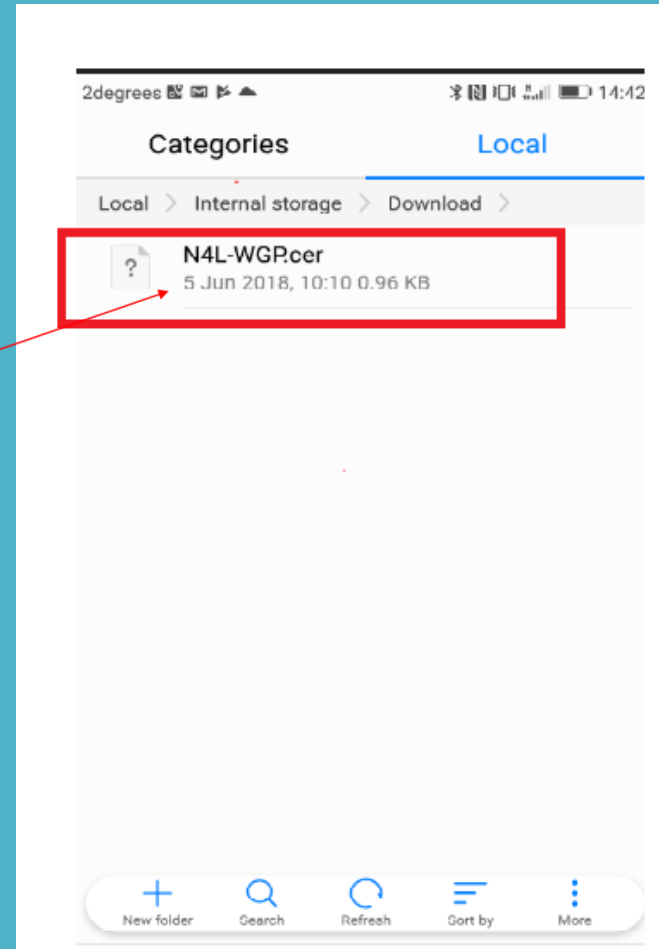
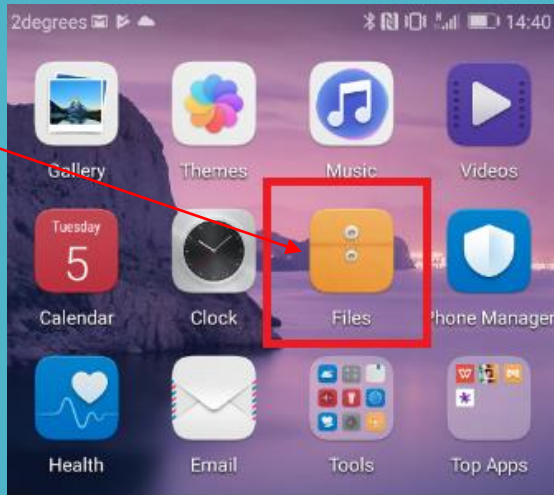


# INSTALLING N4L CERTIFICATE Android Phones

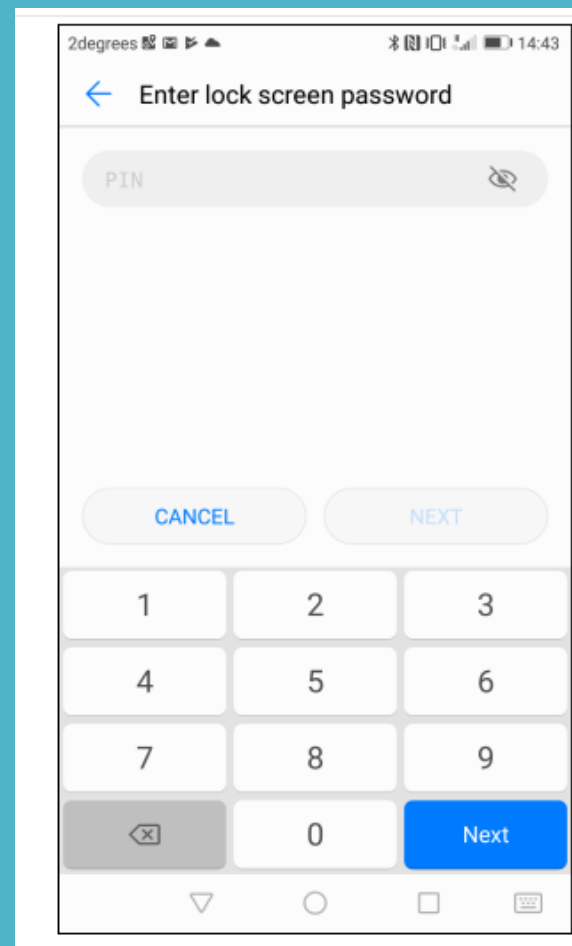
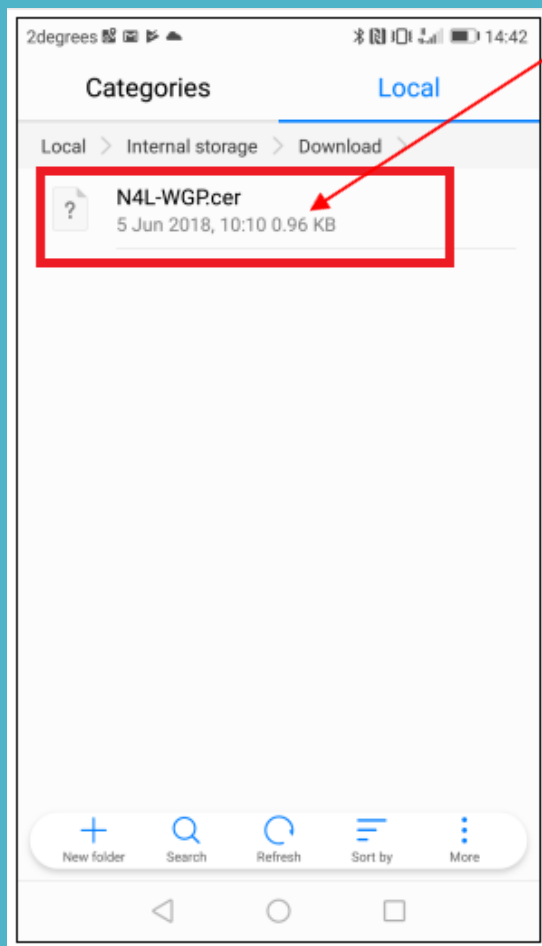
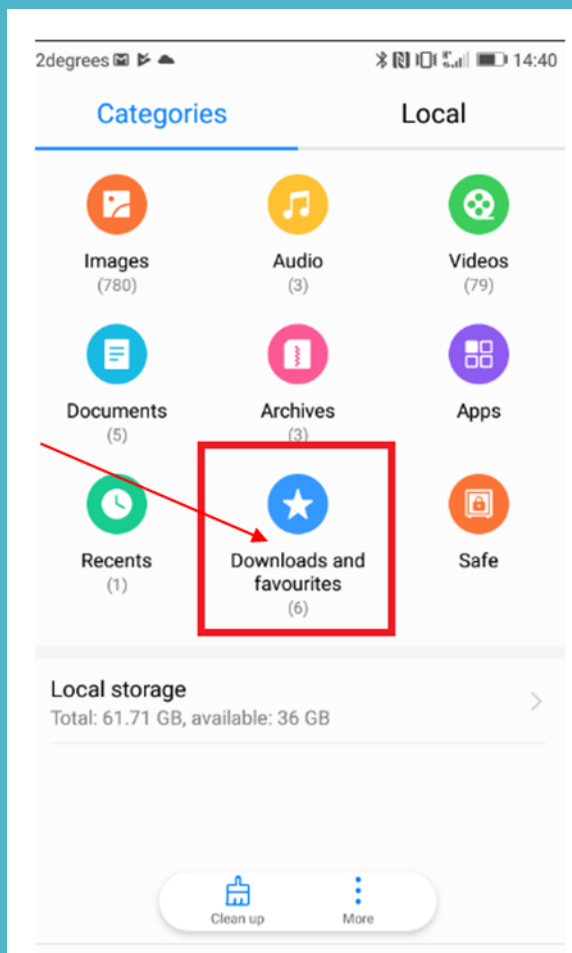
- All WiFi devices need to have the N4L Certificate installed prior to them being able to access any websites.

- N4L Certificate



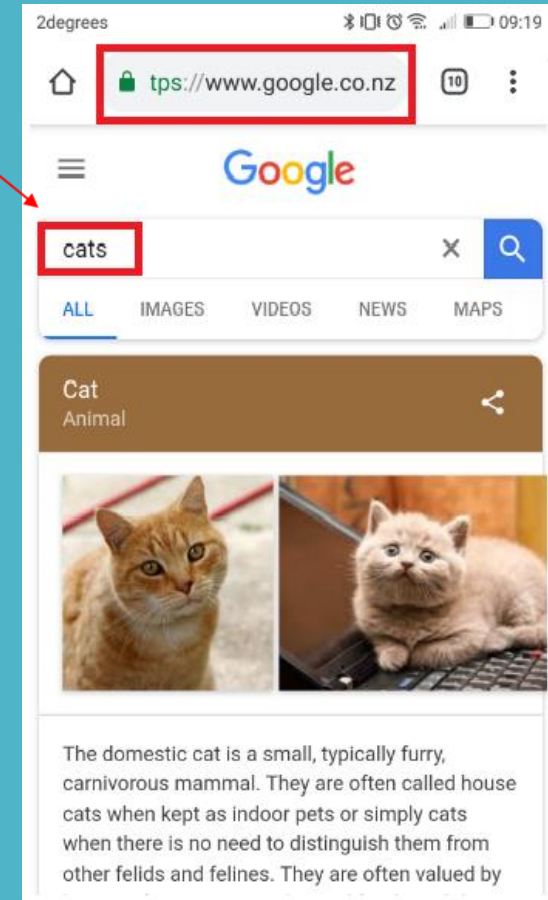
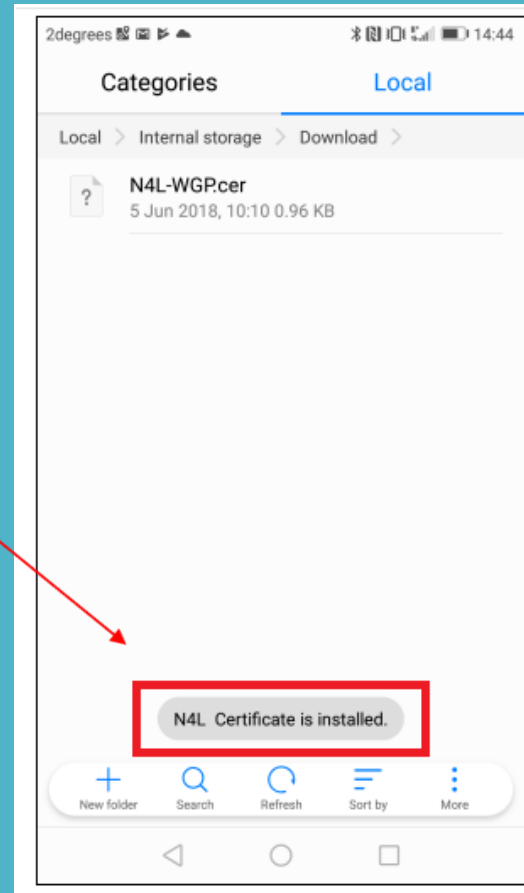
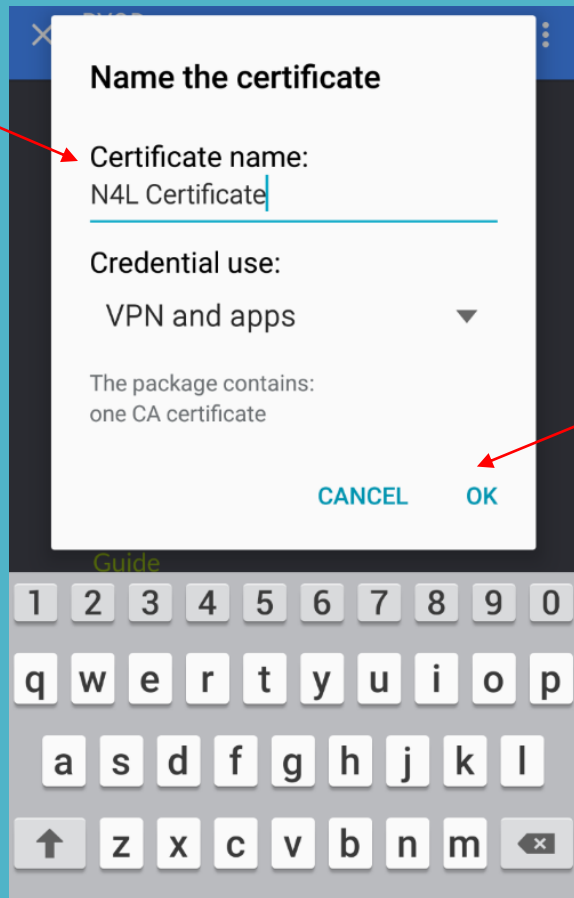
- The downloaded certificate file will move to your downloads on your device. You will need to open this file.



- Certificate will automatically download and open, enter your lock screen password if prompted



- Certificate will automatically download and open, type in the name of the certificate and press ok, certificate is now installed.
- Open a google page and search anything, eg, 'cats'. If you can see anything relating to the subject your internet is now working with the installed certificate.



- If you are unable to find the Certificate in your downloads then try searching under Settings – name the certificate as per instructions on Page 5.
