### Subject: Level ONE History 2021 - Half course

Course Code:	HIST05	Course Length:	Half - two lessons per week
Course Themes:	Protest and Conflict		
Brief Description:			
<p>During the Level 1 History half course, learners will gather information from historical sources (such as artefacts, films, guest speakers, and visits to historical sites) to gain an understanding of the causes, consequences, and significance of important historical events.</p> <p>Historical topics may include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• How New Zealand responded to World War II</li><li>• The role of New Zealand women in World War II</li><li>• How people have fought for their rights:<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>○ New Zealand's fight for Women's Suffrage</li><li>○ The fight for African-American Civil Rights in the USA</li></ul></li><li>• How conflict divided New Zealand during the Springbok Tour</li><li>• A passion project – topic of your choice.</li></ul> <p>The study of History develops a range of valuable skills, including:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Critical thinking</li><li>• Effective research processes</li><li>• Verbal and written communication e.g. formulating an argument, writing paragraphs / essays.</li><li>• Understanding different perspectives</li><li>• Connecting the past with issues in our world today</li><li>• Demonstrating empathy and reflecting on our own biases</li><li>•</li></ul> <p>These skills can be useful in a range of pathways including media, journalism, law, anthropology, archaeology, politics, diplomacy, travel and tourism, museum curation, teaching, archives, research, and genealogy. <b>History helps students become global citizens.</b></p>
