What is a Learning Portfolio?

- A portfolio is a place to keep example of things you can do, and to write goals for what you want to do.
- These examples could be tests or photos of your written work, or photos of your drawings, or short videos, or writing you have typed in, or all sorts of things!
- People can look at your portfolio to understand your learning.

- To show your best learning and create a positive digital footprint. To reflect on your learning and set goals.

Who will see it?

- Your teachers, your family and future employers.

What do I use to create my portfolio?

- Use what you are familiar with and comfortable using regularly. This could be: Google Slides, Wix, Weebly, iMovie, Wordpress, Google Sites etc.

1. Sign up for or open your chosen portfolio.
2. Create a page titled: **About Me**
3. Write about the following:
 - Things you love
 - Things you are passionate about
 - Things that are important to you
 - Skills, strengths and talents
 - People that help support you to be successful (what they do specifically)
 - Other things that you have going on in your life i.e work, sport etc.

Add photos, video and other visual stuff!



SCHOOL

1. Add a new page titled: **School**
2. Write about the following:
 - Your likes and dislikes
 - Subjects that you are strong in (specifically why?)
 - Subjects that you struggle with (specifically Why?)
 - When do you work best?
