## **What is a Learning Portfolio?**

- A portfolio is a goal-driven, purposeful collection of artefacts and reflections that demonstrate a growth of knowledge and skills over time.
- Artefacts are presented using technologies such as audio recordings, graphs, slide shows, video and others.
- Learning portfolios are a way of showcasing achievement and progress.

## **Why should I have one?**

- To create a record of your best learning and a positive digital footprint. To reflect on learning and set goals.

## **Who will see it?**

- Use what you are familiar with and comfortable using regularly. This could be: Google Slides, Wix, Weebly, iMovie, Wordpress, Google Sites etc.

  - When do you work best?



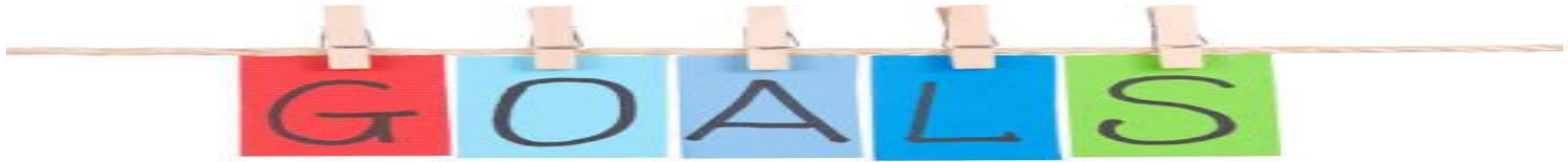

- How can other learners help you/ are there things which other learner's do that stop you from being successful?



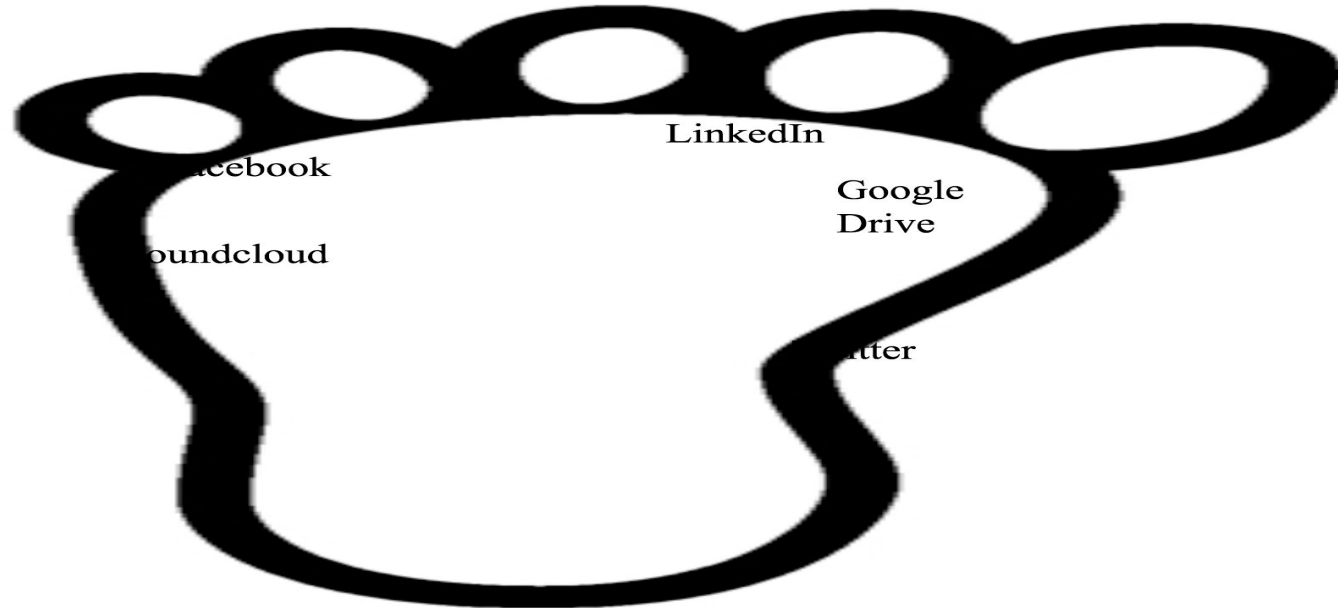


1. Add a new page titled: **Goals**
